Membership in ECAO represents an obligation to the electrical contracting industry and the public to maintain a high standard of business integrity and service. ECAO members shall conform to the following guidelines:

- ❖ to present a favourable contractor image to customers and industry colleagues.*
- ❖ to ensure the customer is given the best possible product at an acceptable price.*
- ❖ to honour the quality and type of material specified in construction contracts, plans and specifications.*
- ❖ to treat industry colleagues and competitors with respect.*
- ❖ to maintain the tendered price, after the closing of tenders, unless the scope of work has changed.*
- ❖ to maintain the tendered price, if the low bidder withdraws or is not accepted.*
- ❖ if tendering through a Bid Depository, to comply with the rules of that Bid Depository.*
- ❖ to avoid soliciting prices from suppliers or subcontractors which one does not intend to use.*
- ❖ to treat as confidential all quotations received from suppliers or subcontractors.*
- ❖ to provide fair and safe working conditions for employees.*
- ❖ to comply with the requirements of the Trades' Qualification Act and the regulations pertaining to the construction and maintenance electrician.*
- ❖ to comply with municipal by-laws regarding the licensing of Master Electricians and Electrical Contractors.*
